
WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin supports and joins in this national effort to help consumers focus on their financial needs in retirement;

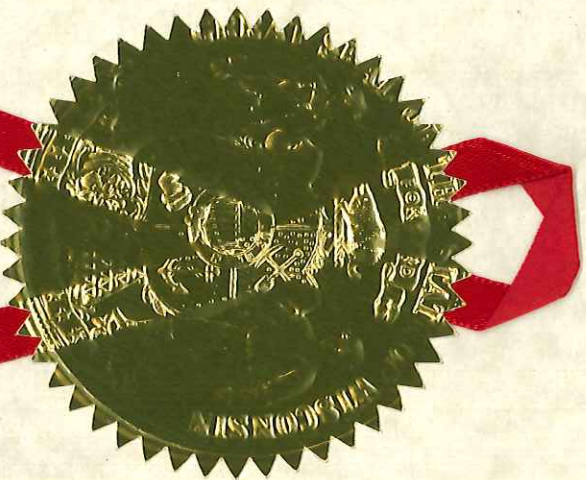
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
